

Snow Removal

The Public Works Department has six (6) snow plows for snow removal for the City of Fountain's streets. There are 85.4 miles of streets for plowing. Call-out for snow removal is initiated by the Police Department. If you have a snow problem that is after hours, please contact the Fountain Police Department. During regular business working hours, please contact the City of Fountain Administration Office at City Hall.

The snow removal route is broken down into six areas for each snow plow. All **First Priority** streets will be plowed and sanded in both directions before moving on to other streets. The priorities are as follows:

First Priority: Arterial streets, chronic problem areas (hills, drifting, etc.), Police Stations, Fire Stations, Railroad Tracks and School Zones. School Zones will be plowed and sanded by 6:30 a.m. unless school is cancelled. All first priority streets will be plowed and/or sanded in both directions.

Second Priority: Major collector streets that intersect with primary roads.

Third Priority: Residential streets only after all primary and secondary streets are completed.
